In 2012, Professor Liu joined NC State University's College of Design as the head of the Department of Graphic Design and Industrial Design. As a professor and head, he is responsible for the academic and administrative successes of the undergraduate Graphic Design and Industrial Design programs, the graduate Graphic Design program, and the graduate Industrial Design program. Professor Liu has also facilitated the establishment of sponsored research/design projects with organizations such as Becton, Dickinson and Company, Bosch-Siemens Home Appliances Group, Eastman Chemical Company, Hanes Brands Inc., IBM, and SAS Institute.

The recipient of the Southern Governors' Association's Innovator Award and an NC State service/extension award, Professor Liu has also received several 'outstanding teaching' awards. He has been an active presenter and speaker at the Industrial Designers Society of America's annual national conferences and many other international conferences. Professor Liu's research and teaching interests include user-experience centered product/service innovation, user-centered design methods, inclusive design, design education, and social responsibility of designers.

Dean Liu graduated from National Cheng Kung University in Taiwan with a BS degree in Industrial Design. He also received his MBA from Georgina State University and Master of Industrial Design degree from Auburn University.
